Main Responsibilities

Monitoring & Reporting

- Monitor the performance of the TPAs' portfolios from the bordereaux received
- Identify reasons for deviation from expected results
- Analyse the premium and claims data to detect any trends/anomalies
- Monitor that adherence to the External Delegated Underwriting Authority agreements is respected
- Work closely with the Pricing team to devise and update pricing guidelines for the TPAs
- Monitor that pricing guidelines are followed strictly
- Recommend any required review of terms
- · Produce regular management reports and dashboards

Technical Control

- Ensure that entries on the system are correctly processed in line with bordereaux received
- Carry out monthly on-site Technical Audits at TPAs' premises
- Liaise with Finance to ensure figures are correctly accounted
